



**Town of Lisbon
Patrol Officer Position**

The Lisbon Police Department is seeking qualified, community oriented, applicants for a full-time Police Officer position. Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- A. Must be 21 years of age **or** 20 years of age with 60 college credits at application closing.
- B. Be in good physical condition.
- C. Pass the MCJA ALERT Test prior to interview date. (non-certified)
- D. Pass the MCJA Physical Fitness Test prior to interview date. (non-certified)
- E. Have a valid Maine driver's license, or the ability to obtain one within 30 days after the employment start date.
- F. Not have extensive traffic record or any criminal record that would make them ineligible to obtain a certificate from the Maine Criminal Justice Academy (MCJA).

Preference may be given to candidates who are certified law enforcement officers, or those who have successfully completed all phases of the Maine Law Enforcement Pre-Service Training Program. All successful candidates will have to pass an extensive background investigation, to include a psychological, polygraph, and medical examination.

The Town of Lisbon offers a competitive salary with starting pay commensurate to training and experience, a progressive health benefit package, educational stipends, and 25-year retirement.
